Camp Opening Times

The camp runs Monday to Friday from 9.30am to 4pm.

Venue

The camp will be taking place in Newpark Hotel, Castlecomer Road, Kilkenny. The camp base room is located in the health club dance studio.

Drop off/ Pick up

Please drop the children off to the back of the hotel at the health club entrance. An instructor will be there to meet you on the first day to show you to the camp base room. The campers will meet in the camp base room each morning at 9.30am. The children can be collected from the camp base room each day at 4pm.

Camper age group

Camper's age groups will range from 7 -13 years.

Lunches

What to bring

Children should bring sun cream and a bottle of water to camp, especially in warmer weather. They will also need their swimming togs and swim hat on the days that they have swimming. Towels will be provided by the health club. The children will be informed about the swimming timetable on the first day of camp and they will have two sessions of swimming during the week.

The children will not need to bring any lunches to camp, as these will be provided for them by the hotel. Please ensure that your child eats a good breakfast before camp each day as they will be more active than usual.
